

Rollinsford Water and Sewer District Annual Meeting Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

When and where is the Annual Meeting being held?

The 2026 Annual Meeting of the Rollinsford Water & Sewer District (RWSD) is being held on March 24th, 2026 at 6pm at Rollinsford Grade School, 487 Locust Street in Rollinsford.

How do I know if I am a member of the Rollinsford Water & Sewer District (RWSD)?

If you live in any residence in Rollinsford that is serviced by the water and/or sewer district, you are a member of the RWSD.

Can I register to participate and vote the night of the meeting?

Yes, you will need to bring a valid photo ID such as a passport or driver's license AND a bill or official document that names you at that residence (e.g., electric bill, cable bill, lease, etc.).

What do I need to bring to vote?

All members must bring a photo ID to verify your identity and eligibility to participate.

Can I attend if I am a renter?

Yes, you can attend if you rent in Rollinsford.

Can I vote if I am a renter?

Yes, if you are eligible to vote and live in the RWSD.

Can I attend if I am a homeowner, non-resident?

Yes, this is a public meeting that anyone can attend. However, you must reside in the RWSD to participate and vote at the meeting.

Is my name on the checklist managed by the Supervisors of the Checklist?

The Supervisors of the Checklist maintain the list of eligible and registered voters. If you wonder if you are currently on the list, you can review the file at the Town Hall during normal business operating hours.

How long will the meeting last?

Depending upon the discussion and questions, the meeting will likely last at least an hour and hopefully no longer than three hours.
